(4.5mm double pointed needles and 5mm double pointed needles) or 1 pair 4.5mm straight needles and 1 pair 5mm straight needles)					
IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE THE CORRECT SIZING. If you tension square has less stitches, use a thinner needle, if more, use a thicker needle.					
<b>Note:</b> The body and sleeves are worked in the round from the lower edge up to the armholes. They are then joined and the yoke is worked as a whole. If you prefer not to use double pointed needles, you can work the sleeves flat by simply adding 2sts to the number of cast on stitches and then stitching the sleeve seams with a one stitch seam allowance, before joining as per the pattern.

## **SWEATER**

### **BODY**

**With 4.25mm circular needles and Col A** cast on 160[176:192:208]sts and join in the round, placing a stitch marker to mark the beginning of the round.

Work in k1, p1 rib stitch until work measures 1½ ins (4cm).

**Change to 5mm circular needles** and work patt from Chart A in stst (ie knit each rnd).

When patt is complete, continue straight in **Col A** until Body measures 15[16:16½:17]ins (38[40:42:44]cm) and leave stitches on circular needle.

### **SLEEVES (worked in the round) Make 2**

**With 4.25mm dpn and Col A** cast on 40[42:44:46]sts and join in the round, placing a stitch marker to mark the beginning of the round. Work in k1, p1 rib stitch until work measures 1½ ins (4cm). **Next rnd:** knit, inc 0[2:0:2]sts evenly across rnd.

**Change to 5mm dpn** and work patt from Chart B in stst (ie knit each rnd).

When chart is complete continue in Col A, inc 1 st after 1<sup>st</sup> st and before every last st of next rnd and every following 9<sup>th</sup>[9<sup>th</sup>:8<sup>th</sup>:8<sup>th</sup>]rnd a total of 10[10:12:12] times until you have 60[64:68:72]sts.

Continue straight until sleeve measures 18[18½:19: 19½]ins (46[47:48:49]cm).

Place the next 10[12:14:16]sts on to a stitch holder (underarm stitches) and place the remaining 50[52:54:56]sts onto a separate stitch holder.

**Alternatively:**

**SLEEVES (worked flat) Make 2**

**With 4.25mm straight needles and Col A** cast on 42[44:46:48]sts.

**Row 1:** k1, p1 to end.

**Row 2:** k1, p1 to end.

These last two rows form the rib stitch. Continue in rib stitch until work measures 1½ ins (4cm).

**Next row:** knit, inc 0[2:0:2]sts evenly across row (not at ends of row).

**Change to 5mm straight needles** and work patt from Chart B in stst (ie knit rs, purl ws).

When chart is complete continue in Col A, inc 1 st at each end of next row and every following 9<sup>th</sup>[9<sup>th</sup>:8<sup>th</sup>:8<sup>th</sup>]row a total of 10[10:12:12] times until you have 62[66:70:74]sts.

Continue straight until sleeve measures 17½ [18:18½:19]ins (45[46:47:48]cm), ending on a ws row.

**Next row:** Cast off 1 st, knit to end.

**Next row:** Cast off 1 st, purl to end. (60[64:68:72]sts)

Slip all remaining stitches the last 5[6:7:8]sts and the first 5[6:7:8]sts onto a stitch holder, as if to join in the round

(underarm stitches). Slip the remaining 50[52:54:56]sts onto a stitch holder. Sew sleeve seam.

**YOKE**

Join the body and sleeves:

**With 5mm circular needles and using Col A,** remove stitch marker and place the last 5[6:7:8] sts and the next 5[6:7:8] sts onto a stitch holder (underarm sts).

Knit across the 50[52:54:56]sts from first sleeve from stitch holder, k across 70[76:82:88]sts for the front, k across 50[52:54:56]sts from the second sleeve and k across 70[76:82:88]sts for the back and pm to mark the start of the round (240[256:272:288]sts).

Work patt from Chart C, noting the patt decreases, changing to a shorter circular needle as and when necessary.

When chart is complete there will be 90[96:102:108]sts remaining.

**NECKBAND**

**Change to 4.5mm circular or dpn and Col A** and knit first rnd, dec 18[22:26:30]sts evenly across rnd.

Work 1x1 rib until neckband measures 4cm.

Cast off loosely using Russian cast off method:

**Russian Cast off**

K2, slip 2 knit sts back onto left needle and k2tog, \*k1, sl sts onto left needle, k2tog; rep from \* to end.

**MAKING UP**

Graft underarm seams using Kitchener Stitch for an invisible seam. Weave in loose ends.

**CARDIGAN**

**BODY**

**With 4.25mm circular needles and Col A** cast on 152[168:184:200]sts, but do not join in the round  
Work in k1, p1 rib stitch until work measures 1½ ins (4cm).

**Change to 5mm circular needles** and work patt from Chart A in stst.

When patt is complete, continue straight in **Col A** until Body measures 15[16:16½:17]ins (38[40:42:44]cm) and leave stitches on circular needle.

**SLEEVES (worked in the round) Make 2**

**With 4.25mm dpn and Col A** cast on 40[42:44:46]sts and join in the round, placing a stitch marker to mark the beginning of the round. Work in k1, p1 rib stitch until work measures 1½ ins (4cm).

**Next rnd:** knit, inc 0[2:0:2]sts evenly across rnd.

**Change to 5mm dpn** and work patt from Chart B in stst (ie knit each rnd).

When chart is complete continue in Col A, inc 1 st after 1<sup>st</sup> st and before every last st of next rnd and every following 9<sup>th</sup>[9<sup>th</sup>:8<sup>th</sup>:8<sup>th</sup>]rnd a total of 10[10:12:12] times until you have 60[64:68:72]sts.

Continue straight until sleeve measures 18[18½:19: 19½]ins (46[47:48:49]cm).

Place the next 10[12:14:16]sts on to a stitch holder (underarm stitches) and place the remaining 50[52:54:56]sts onto a separate stitch holder.

**Alternatively:**

**SLEEVES (worked flat) Make 2**

**With 4.25mm straight needles and Col A** cast on 42[44:46:48]sts.

**Row 1:** k1, p1 to end.

**Row 2:** k1, p1 to end.

These last two rows form the rib stitch. Continue in rib stitch until work measures 1½ ins (4cm).

**Next row:** knit, inc 0[2:0:2]sts evenly across row (not at ends of row).

**Change to 5mm straight needles** and work patt from Chart B in stst.

When chart is complete continue in Col A, inc 1 st at each end of next row and every following 9<sup>th</sup>[9<sup>th</sup>:8<sup>th</sup>:8<sup>th</sup>]row a total of 10[10:12:12] times until you have 62[66:70:74]sts.

Continue straight until sleeve measures 17½ [18:18½:19]ins (45[46:47:48]cm), ending on a ws row.

**Next row:** Cast off 1 st, knit to end.

**Next row:** Cast off 1 st, purl to end. (60[64:68:72]sts)

Slip all remaining stitches the last 5[6:7:8]sts and the first 5[6:7:8]sts onto a stitch holder, as if to join in the round (underarm stitches). Slip the remaining 50[52:54:56]sts onto a stitch holder. Sew sleeve seam.

## YOKE

Join the body and sleeves:

**With 5mm circular needles and using Col A,** knit across 32[35:38:41]sts on right front, then slip next 10[12:14:16]sts onto a stitch holder for armhole, knit the 50[52:54:56]sts from first sleeve from stitch holder, k across 68[74:80:86]sts for the back, slip next 10[12:14:16]sts onto a stitch holder for armhole, k across 50[52:54:56]sts from the second sleeve and k across 32[35:38:41]sts for the left front. (232:248:264:280]sts).

**Next row:** purl

Work patt from Chart C, beginning with the 9<sup>th</sup> column, noting the patt decreases.

When chart is complete there will be 87[93:99:105]sts remaining.

## NECKBAND

**Change to 4.5mm circular and Col A** and knit first row, dec 15[19:23:27]sts evenly across rnd.

Work 1x1 rib until neckband measures 4cm.

Cast off loosely using Russian cast off method:

### Russian Cast off

K2, slip 2 knit sts back onto left needle and k2tog, \*k1, sl sts onto left needle, k2tog; rep from \* to end.

## BUTTON BAND

**Using 4.25mm circular needles and Col A,** pick up and knit 3 out of every 4 sts evenly down the front left of the cardigan, working 1 st for each row of neckband and waistband.

Work 1x1 rib until band measures 4cm.

Cast off loosely.

## BUTTONHOLD BAND

**Using 4.25mm circular needles and Col A,** pick up and knit the same amount of sts as for Button Band.

Work 3 rows in 1x1 rib.

**Next row:** rib 4, \*yo, rib 2tog, rib x; to last 4 sts, yo, rib 2tog, rib 2. To determine the value of x, decide how many buttons you would like to add and work out how many you will need to rib to evenly space the buttonholes along the band.

Eg. If you have picked up 100 sts and you would like to add 8 buttons:

$$100 - 4\text{rib}(\text{beg}) - 4\text{rib}(\text{end}) = 96$$

Divide by number of buttons:

$$96 / 8 = 12$$

So the patt will be \*yo, rib2tog, rib 10\* (so the total of the spacing equals 12).

## MAKING UP

Graft underarm seams using Kitchener Stitch for an invisible seam. Weave in loose ends.

## SLOUCHY BEANIE

Sizes S[M:L]

**With 4.5mm circular or dpn and Col A** cast on 56[70:84]sts and work in 1x1 rib until hat measures 2 ins (5cm)

**Change to 5mm circular or dpn** and work patt from Chart C in stst (ie knit each rnd), but miss rows 8-16.

Continue in Col A until hat measures 10 ins (25cm).

**Next row:** \*k2tog, k5; rep to end (48[60:72]sts).

**Next row:** knit

**Next row:** \*k2tog, k4; rep to end (40[50:60]sts).

**Next row:** knit

**Next row:** \*k2tog, k3; rep to end (32[40:48]sts).

**Next row:** knit

**Next row:** \*k2tog, k2; rep to end (24[30:36]sts).

**Next row:** knit

**Next row:** \*k2tog, k1; rep to end (16[20:24]sts).

**Next row:** k2tog to end (8[10:12]sts).

Cut yarn leaving long tail, weave through remaining stitches, pull tight and secure. Weave in ends.
