Jaffa Stripe Baby Cardigan and Hat

Size

To fit age 3-6 months

Actual size 52cm (20 ½")

Length from shoulder 26cm (10")

Sleeve Length 17cm (7")

Materials

1 x 100g Kiddies Couture DK Prints
040 Jaffa Stripe

1 x 100g Kiddies Supersoft DK 225
Cream

1 pair 3.25mm needles

1 pair 4mm needles

6 buttons



Back

Using 225 Cream and
3.25mm needles

□ Cast on 55sts

□ Row 1: k1, * p1, k1, rep
from * to end. (this row
forms Moss Stitch). Repeat
8 times

□ Row 10: moss stitch 7 inc
in next 2 sts * moss st 11 inc
in next 2 sts, rep from * to

last 7 sts, moss st to end
(63sts)

Change to 4mm needles

□ Row 1: k6, p1, k4, p1, *
k9, p1, k4, p1, rep from * to
last 6sts, k6

□ Row 2: k7, p4, *k11, p4,
rep from * to last 7 sts, k7

Using the Intarsia Method
(see notes) Join in contrast

colour and work cable in
main as follows:

□ Row 1: inc moss st 6, in
225 Cream p1, c4, p1, in
Contrast k9, in 225 Cream
p1, c4, p1 in Contrast k9, in
225 Cream p1 c4, p1, in
Contrast k9, in 225 Cream
p1, c4, p1, in Contrast moss
st 6

□ Row 2: (keeping colours
correct) moss st 6, k1, p4,

k1, p9, k1, p4, k1, k9, k1, p4,
k1, p9, k1, p4, k1, moss st 6

□ Row 3: moss st 6, p1, k4,
p1, k9, p1, k4, p1, k9, p1,
k4, p1, k9, p1, k4, p1, moss
st 6

□ Row 4: repeat Row 2

□ Repeat 30 times ending
with WS

Shape Armholes

□ Keeping patt correct, dec
1 st at each end of next and
foll 3 alt rows (55sts)

□ Work 30 rows in patt

□ Cast off

Left Front

Using 225 Cream and
3.25mm needles

□ Cast on 29sts

□ Work 9 rows in moss
stitch as for Back

□ Row 10: moss st 8 inc in
next 2 sts, moss st 11 inc in
next 2sts, moss st 5 inc in
last st (34sts)

Change to 4mm needles

□ Row 1: k6, p1, k4, p1, k9,
p1, k4 (p1, k4) 4 times

□ Row 2: (k1, p1) 3 times,
k2, p4, k11, p4, k7

Using the Intarsia Method,
join in contrast colour and
work cable in 225 Cream as
follows:

□ Row 1: in Contrast moss
st 6, in 225 Cream, p1 c4,
p1, in Contrast k9, in 225
Cream p1, c4, p1, moss st 7
sts

□ Row 2: (keeping colours
correct) moss t 7, k1, p4, k1,
k9, k1, p4, k1, moss st 6

□ Row 3: moss st 6, p1, k4,
p1, k9, p1, k4, p1, moss st 7

□ Row 4: Repeat row 2

□ Repeat 30 times ending
with WS

Shape Armholes

□ Keeping patt correct dec
1 st at Armhole Edge on
next and foll 3 alt rows
(30sts)

□ Work 21 rows in patt

Shape Neck

□ Patt 22sts, cast off last
8sts, turn and rejoin yarn
(when working Right Front
cast off 1st 8 sts, patt to end
on this row). Keeping patt
correct, dec 1st at Neck
Edge on next 4 rows, then
foll alt row (17sts).

□ Work 5 rows straight in
patt

□ Cast off

Right Front

□ Using 225 Cream and
3.25mm needles

□ Cast on 29sts

□ Work 9 rows in moss st,
making button hole on 3rd
row as follows: k1, p1, k1,
yfwd, k2tog, *p1, k1, rep
from * to end

□ Row 10: inc in 1st st, moss
st 5 inc in next 2sts, moss st
11, inc in next 2 sts, moss st
8 (34sts)

Change to 4mm needles

□ Row 1: moss st 7, p1, k4,
p1, k9, p1, k4, p1, moss st 6

□ Row 2: k7, p4, k11, p4, k2
(p1, k1) 3 times

□ Using the Intarsia
Method, join in contrast
colour and work cable in
225 Cream as follows:

□ Row 1: in 225 Cream
moss st 7, p1, c4, p1, in
contrast k9, in 225 Cream
p1, c4, p1, in 225 Cream
(k1, p1) 3 times

□ Row 2: (keeping colours
correct) moss st 6, k1, p4,
k1, k9, k1, p4, k1, moss st 7

□ Row 3: moss st 7, p1, k4,
p1, k9, p1, k4, p1 (k1, p1) 3
times

□ Row 4: Repeat row 2

□ Repeat 30 times ending
with WS. At the same time
make further Button Holes
as before on every 14th row
from previous Button Hole.

Shape Armholes

- Complete as given for Left Front, noting the variation on 1st row of Shaping Neck
- Cast off

Sleeves – both alike

Using 225m Cream and 3.25mm needles

- Cast on 33sts
- Work 9 rows in moss st
- Row 10: p4, inc in next st purlwise *p2, inc in next st purlwise, rep from * to last 4 sts, p4 (42sts)

Change to 4mm needles

- Row 1: k3, p1, k4, p1, k9, p1, k4, p1, k9, p1, k4, p1, k3
- Row 2: k4, p4 (k11, p4) twice, k4
- Using the Intarsia Method, join in contrast colour and work in patt as for Back and Fronts as follows:
 - Row 1: k3, p1, c4, p1, k9, p1, c4, p1, moss st 9, p1, c4, p1, k3
 - Row 2: p3, k1, p4, k1, moss st 9, k1, p4, k1, k9, k1, p4, k1, p3
 - Row 3: inc in 1st st, k2, p1, k4, p1, k9, p1, k4, p1, moss st 9, p1, k4, p1, k2, inc in last st (35sts)

- Row 4: p4, k1, p4, k1, moss st 9, k1, p4, k1, k9, k1, p4, k1, p4
- Continue in patt as set in c 1 st at each end of 3rd row and every foll 4th row until 60 sts are on needle
- Work 7 rows straight.

Shape Top

- Dec 1st at each end of foll 3 rows (52sts)
- Patt 1 row
- Cast off

Collar

- Using 3.25mm needles and 225 Cream
- Cast on 53 sts
- Row 1: k1, *p1, k1, rep from * to end
- Row 2: p1, *k1, p1, rep from * to end
- Repeat rows 1 & 2 twice
- Change to 4mm needles
- Repeat row 1 only 11 times.
- Cast off loosely in moss stitch

Cap

Using 3.25mm needles and 225 Cream

- Cast on 78sts. work 15 rows in 2x2 rib
- Row 16: work in rib inc 6 sts evenly along row (84sts)
- Change to 4mm needles and using the Intarsia Method, join in contrast colour and work cable in 225 Cream as follows:



- Row 1: using Contrast k3, in 225 Cream p1, c4, p1, in Contrast moss st 6, in 225 Cream p1, c4, p1, in Contrast k6, in 225 Cream p1, c4, p1, in Contrast moss st 6, , in 225 Cream p1, c4, p1, in Contrast k6, in 225 Cream p1, c4, p1, in Contrast moss st 6, , in 225 Cream p1, c4, p1, in Contrast k6, in 225 Cream p1, c4, p1, in Contrast k3

Keeping colours correct proceed as follows:

□ Row 2: k3, k1, p4, k1, k6, k1, p4, k1, moss st 6, k1, p4, k1, k6, k1, p4, k1, moss st 6, k1, p4, k1, k6, k1, p4, k1, moss st 6, k1, p4, k1, k3

□ Row 3: k3, p1, k4, p1, moss st 6, p1, k4, p1, k6, p1, k4, p1 moss st 6, p1. K4, p1, k6, p1, k4, p1, moss st 6, p1, k4, p1, k6, p1, k4, p1, k3

□ Row 4: repeat row 2

□ Work 19 more rows ending with RS row.

□ Next Row: P, dec 5sts evenly along row (79sts)

Shape Crown (using 225 Cream)

□ Row 1: k6, *k1, k2tog, k4, rep from * to last 3sts, k3 (69sts)

□ Row 2 & every foll alt row: p

□ Row 3: k1, k2tog, k3, *k1, k2tog, k3, rep from * to last 3sts, k1, k2tog (57sts)

□ Row 5: k2tog, k3, * k2tog, k3, rep from * to last 2sts, k2tog (45sts)

□ Row 7: k2tog, k2, *k2tog, k2, rep from *to last 1st, k1 (34sts)

□ Row 9: k2tog, k1, *k2tog, rep from *to last st, k1 (23sts)

□ Row 11: k1, * k2tog, rep from *to end (12sts)

□ Row 12: p2tog 6 times (6sts)

□ Break off yarn , run through rem sts, draw up and fasten off

Intarsia is a technique used to incorporate areas of color into your knitting. This could mean pictures, shapes or polka dots. For each block of contrasting color you will use a different length of yarn. The yarn is not carried across the back of the work, as in Fair Isle, but rather twisted around the main color at the edges of the secondary color.
