



Seriously Chunky Barley Bag

Materials

2 x 100g balls of Seriously Chunky model worked in 4884 Barley

Pair of 8mm needles

2 bag handles

Instructions

Bag Front and Back (knit two the same)

Cast on 26 stitches on 8mm needles

Row 1: Knit 12, place marker, k 14

Row 2 and all even number rows: P, slipping marker as necessary

Row 3: K

Row 5: Knit to two stitches before marker, K2Tog, K2, SSK, knit to end (24sts)

Row 7: K

Repeat rows 5-8, 5 more times. 14 stitches remain

Next Row. K1, P1 across row removing marker.

Next Row: p1, K1

Repeat these two rows to continue in K1 P1 rib for approx.. 5cms.

Cast off in pattern.

Make Up

Neatly sew side and bottom seams, leaving approx. 5cms at top of side seams open. Pass Rib section through bag handles and stitch in place on wrong side to secure handle.

Abbreviations

SSK – Slip 2 Stitches Knitwise, insert the tip of the left hand needle into the fronts of these two stitches from the left and knit them together from this position.
