



## Seriously Chunky Bluebell Bag

### Materials

2 x 100g of Seriously Chunky model worked in 237 Bluebell

Pair of 8mm double pointed needles

Cable needle

2 bag handles

### Instructions

Cast on 38 stitches in a waste yarn of a similar thickness to Seriously Chunky. Divide stitches equally between the needles and knit in the round for 3 or 4 rows. Change to 237 Bluebell

Row 1: P1, k4, p1, k8, p1, k4, p1, k8, p1, k4

Row 2: as Row 1

Row 3, P1, k4, p1, C4b, c4f, p1, k4, p1, k4, p1, C4b, C4f, p1, k4

Row 4: as Row 1

Repeat these 4 rows a further 4 times (20 rows in total)

Then repeat Row 1 a further 3 times

Next Row; P1, K4, p1, K8, \*cast off 11 sts in pattern, K 8 sts, turn.

Work 3 rows of stocking stitch on these 8 stitches, cast off\*\*

Rejoin yarn and work from \* to \*\*

### Make Up

Fold bag in half, wrong sides together. The cable panels form the centre front of each side of the bag. Graft together the cast on edge, removing waste yarn. Use the extension flap at the top of each cable panel to fold over the circular bag handles and stitch down the flaps to the wrong side of the bag to hold handles in place.

**Abbreviations:** C4B or C4F – cable 4 **back** or cable 4 **front**, Slip next 2 sts onto a cable needle and hold at back (or front) of work. Knit next 2 sts from left hand needle, the knit stitches from cable needle.
