Materials

Baby Pato DK Marine (712) (Colour A)	50g	1	1	1	2
Baby Pato DK Sky (711) (Colour B)	50g	1	1	1	2

Alternative shade combinations:

Baby Pato Marine (712) (Col A)/Baby Pato Aqua (713) (Col B)

Baby Pato Sand (708) (Col A)/Baby Pato Cream (703) (Col B)

Baby Pato Silver (709) (Col A)/Baby Pato Spearmint (710) (Col B)

Needles

1 pair of 3mm (UK 11 – US 2.5)
1 pair of 3.75mm (UK 9 – US 5)

Buttons

1[1:2:2] buttons

Tension

20 stitches and 28 rows to
10cm (4in) over stocking stitch
on 3.75mm needles

IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE THE CORRECT SIZING. If your tension square has less stitches, use a thinner needle, if more, use a thicker needle.

Abbreviations

col	colour	k	knit
dec	decrease	p	purl
st	stitch	rs	right side
patt	pattern	ws	wrong side

Pattern

Work 6 rows in col A and 6 rows in Col B, alternating throughout garment.

2x2 rib

1st row: (k2, p2) to last st, k1
2nd row: p1, (k2, p2) to end

BACK

With 3.25mm needles and Col A cast on 58[62:64:68] sts and work 8 rows in 2x2 rib

Change to 4mm needles and Colour B and working in patt:

Next row: K3[2:4:3], K2tog, (K3, K2tog) 10[12:12:14] times, K3[2:4:3]. (48[50:52:54]sts)

Next row and following alternating rows – purl

Working in stst and patt continue until Back measures 9[10:13:16] cm (4½[5:6:7]ins) ending with a ws row*

Shape Armholes

Cast off 3[4:4:4] sts at beginning of next 2 rows. (42[44:46:48]sts)

Work 4 rows in patt dec 1 st at each end of every row. (34[36:36:40]sts)

Work 5[5:5:7] rows in patt dec 1 st at each end of next and every following alt row. (28[30:30:32]sts)

Work 11[13:13:15] rows in patt w/o shaping.

Shape back neck

Next row: k7, turn, leave rem 21[23:23:25]sts on a stitch holder.

Working on these 7sts proceed as follows in patt:

Work 2rows dec 1 st at neck edge in each row. (5sts)

Work 1 row in patt without shaping.

Cast off.

With rs facing, rejoin yarn to remaining stitches on stitch holder and cast off next 14[16:16:18]sts and knit across the remaining 7 sts.

Work 2 rows in patt dec 1 st at neck edge in each row. (5sts)

Work 1rows in patt without shaping.

Cast off.

FRONT

Work as for Back up to *.

Shape armholes

Cast off 3[4:4:4] sts at beginning of next 2 rows. (42[44:46:48]sts)

Work 2 rows in patt dec 1 st at each end of both rows. (38[40:42:44]sts)

Divide for Front Opening

Next row: K2tog, K15[16:17:18], turn leaving rem 21[22:23:24]sts on a stitch holder.

Working on these rem 16[17:18:19]sts only and in patt:

Next row: Purl to last 2 sts, P2tog. (15[16:17:18]sts)

Work 5[5:5:7] rows dec 1 st at armhole edge in next and every foll alt row. (12[13:14:14]sts)

Work 0[2:4:4] rows w/o shaping.

Shape Neck

Next row: Cast off 2[3:4:4]sts, purl to end. (10[10:10:10]sts)

**Work 2 rows in patt dec 1 st at neck edge in both rows. (8[8:8:10]sts)

Work 5[5:5:7] rows in patt dec 1 st at neck edge in next and every foll alt row. (5[5:5:6]sts)

Work 7 rows in patt w/o shaping. Cast off**

With rs facing, rejoin yarn to rem 21[22:23:24]sts on stitch holder, cast off 4 sts and knit to last 2 sts, k2tog. (16[17:18:19]sts)

Next row: P2tog, purl to end. (15[16:17:18]sts)

Work 5[5:5:7] rows in patt dec 1 st at armhole edge in next and every foll alt row. (12[13:14:14]sts)

Work 0[1:3:3] rows in patt w/o shaping.

Shape Neck

Next row: Cast off 2[3:4:4] sts, knit end. (10[10:10:10]sts)

Next row: purl.

Work from ** to ** as given for first side of neck.

Neckband

Join shoulder seams.

With rs facing using 3.25mm needles (you may find this easier on circular needles – particularly for smaller sizes) and Colour A pick up and knit 16[17:18:20]sts evenly up right front side of neck, 3[3:5:5]sts evenly down right side of back neck, 14[16:16:18]sts across cast off sts at back of neck, 3[3:5:5]sts evenly up left side of back neck and 16[17:18:20]sts down left front side of neck. (52[56:62:68]sts)

Work 6 rows in 2x2 rib.

Cast off in 2x2 rib.

Left Front Placket

With rs facing and using 3.25mm needles and Colour A pick up and knit 6sts evenly along neckband and 6[8:10:12]sts down neck opening, cast on 1 st. (13[15:17:19]sts)

Next row: knit

Next row: (2x2 rib) to last st, k1.

Next row: P1, (2x2 rib to end) to end.

Next row: Rib 4, cast off 2sts, (rib 0[0:4:6], cast off 2sts) 0[0:1:1] times, rib to end.

Next row: (Rib 0[0:4:4], cast on 2sts) 0[0:1:1] times, rib 7[9:5:7], cast on 2st, rib 4.

Work 2 rows in 2x2 rib.

Cast off in rib.

Right Front Placket

Using 3.25mm needles and Colour A pick up and knit 6[8:10:12] sts evenly up neck opening and 6sts along neckband.

Next row: knit

Next row: *k2, p2; rep from * to end

Next row: *p2, k2; rep from * to end

Work last two rows 2 more times
(6 rows of rib in total).
Cast off in rib.

Armhole Borders

With rs facing using 3.25mm
needles and Colour A, pick up
and knit 51[57:61:67]sts evenly
all around armhole edge.

Next row: knit

Work 6 rows in 2x2 rib.
Cast off in rib.

To make up

Slip stitch buttonhole placket
lower edge to the front cast on
stitches. Stitch right front placket
behind it. Sew button(s) in place.
Join side seams.

Steam and shape and leave to
dry flat.
