



## ***Seriously Chunky Bag & Scarf Combo***

**Materials:** 3 x 100g balls Seriously Chunky

(model worked in Magenta 5410)

Set of 7mm needles

1m of 1in (2cm) wide ribbon (colour of your choice)

2m of 5/8 in (1.5cm) wide ribbon (colour of your choice)

Lining Fabric 23 x 16in (58 x 41cm)

Button 1in (2.5cm) diameter

**Size:** 13 x 12in (33 x 30cm)

**Tension:** 8sts and 15 rows to 4in (10cm) square over moss stitch on 7mm needles.

**Main Bag** make 2

Cast on 25 sts

**Row 1:** K1, p1 to end

**Row 2:** K1, p1 to end

Carry on until work measures 8in (20cm)

**Next Row:** \*k1, wrap yrn once, p1, wrap yrn once rep from \* to end

**Next Row:** K1, p1 to end, dropping yarn-over stitches

Rep this row twice

**Next Row:** \*k1, wrap yrn twice, p1, wrap yrn twice, rep from \*to end

**Next Row:** K1, p1 to end, dropping yarn-over stitches

**Next Row:** K1, p1 to end

Rep Row 1 and 2

Cast off.

**Handles** make 2

Cast on 4 sts

**Row 1:** K1, p1 to end

**Row 2:** P1, k1 to end

Rep Row 1 and 2 until work measures 5 ¼ in (13 ½cm) long

**Next Row:** K row

**Next Row:** P row

Rep these two rows until work measures 14 ¼ in (36 ½ cm) long





**Next Row:** K1, p1, rep to end

**Next Row:** P1, k1, rep to end

Rep these two rows until work measures 19 ½ in (50cm) long

Cast off.

### **Making up**

Sew bag together and attach the handles to the top edge of each side.

Thread the 1in (2cm) wide ribbon through the upper row of dropped stitches on the bag.

Cut to length and sew the ends together.

Thread the longer length of ribbon through the lower set of dropped stitches.

Start in the centre of the front and thread around the bag to come in centre again.

Pull the ribbon level and tie in a bow.

Cut two pieces 11 ¼ x 12 in (29 x 31cm) for main part of the bag and cut two pieces 20 ¾ x 2 in (53 x 5 cm) for handles. Sew lining together along the two sides and bottom. Sew in the lining on the handles.

Insert the lining and slip stitch the bag.

Sew the button in the middle of the upper edge.

Make a cord 6in (15cm) long from the yarn and sew ends an inch apart opposite the button.

### **Scarf**

**Materials:** 2 x 100g balls Seriously Chunky

Set of 10mm needles

1.5 m of ½ in (1.2 cm) wide ribbon (colour of your choice)

**Size:** approx. 2.3m

**Tension:** 7sts and 9 rows to 4in (10cm) square over pattern on 10mm needles.

Cast on 7sts

Row 1: K1, p1, rep to end

Row 2: K1, p1, rep to end

Row 3: K1, p1, rep to end

Row 4: \* k1, wrap yrn twice, p1, wrap yrn twice, \*rep to end.

Repeat rows 1-4, dropping yarn-over stitches of the fourth row

Continue until the scarf is the desired length ending on a row 3 and cast off.

Cut the ribbon in half and thread it through long gaps at either end, row 4 and 4<sup>th</sup> from last row.
